## **Battery Recycling**



The NHS Supply Chain Batteries and Torches framework covers a wide range of products from standard alkaline AA and AAA batteries to high power alternatives and rechargeable batteries.

As the main supplier on this framework, AllBatteries UK Ltd work with EcoSurety Ltd to provide containers, arrange collections and transport and recycle through a registered waste carrier company.

## There are a number of collection receptacles available for sites

- Small battery bucket packs
- Small barrel (30 litres)
- Medium barrel (120 litres)
- Large barrel (220 litres).

## Recommended storage of waste portable batteries

- Batteries should be placed carefully and not thrown into barrels
- Lead acid batteries should not be mixed with any other type of batteries
- Mixed waste portable batteries can contain up to 5% (by weight) of lithium
- Batteries should be stored in a dry area under cover
- Do not allow water or other liquid into the container
- Keep batteries away from heat sources.




